*Opening Scripture Ezekiel 36:22-27*

<sup>22.</sup> “Therefore say to the house of Israel, Thus says the Lord God: It is not for your sake, O house of Israel, that I am about to act, but for the sake of my holy name, which you have profaned among the nations to which you came. <sup>23.</sup> And I will vindicate the holiness of my great name, which has been profaned among the nations, and which you have profaned among them. And the nations will know that I am the Lord, declares the Lord God, when through you I vindicate My holiness before their eyes. <sup>24.</sup> I will take you from the nations and gather you from all the countries and bring you into your own land. <sup>25.</sup> I will sprinkle clean water on you, and you shall be clean from all your uncleannesses, and from all your idols I will cleanse you. <sup>26.</sup> And I will give you a new heart, and a new spirit I will put within you. ESV Second Scripture Reading: Ezekiel 36:28-38

**28.** You shall dwell in the land that I gave to your fathers, and you shall be my people, and I will be your God. **29.** And I will deliver you from all your uncleannesses. And I will summon the grain and make it abundant and lay no famine upon you. **30.** I will make the fruit of the tree and the increase of the field abundant, that you may never again suffer the disgrace of famine among the nations. **31.** Then you will remember your evil ways, and your deeds that were not good, and you will loathe yourselves for your iniquities and your abominations. **32.** It is not for your sake that I will act, declares the Lord God; let that be known to you. Be ashamed and confounded for your ways, O house of Israel. **33.** “Thus says the Lord God: On the day that I cleanse you from all your iniquities, I will cause the cities to be inhabited, and the waste places shall be rebuilt. **34.** And the land that was desolate shall be tilled, instead of being the desolation that it was in the sight of all who passed by. **35.** And they will say, ‘This land that was desolate has become like the garden of Eden, and the waste and desolate and ruined cities are now fortified and inhabited.’ **36.** Then the nations that are left all around you shall know that I am the Lord; I have rebuilt the ruined places and replanted that which was desolate. I am the Lord; I have spoken, and I will do it. **37.** “Thus says the Lord God: This also I will let the house of Israel ask me to do for them: to increase their people like a flock. **38.** Like the flock for sacrifices, like the flock at Jerusalem during her appointed feasts, so shall the waste cities be filled with flocks of people. Then they will know that I am the Lord.”

***Pastor's Text John 14:25-31***

<sup>25.</sup> “These things I have spoken to you while I am still with you. <sup>26.</sup> But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, he will teach you all things and bring to your remembrance all that I have said to you. <sup>27.</sup> Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you. Not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your hearts be troubled, neither let them be afraid. <sup>28.</sup> You heard me say to you, ‘I am going away, and I will come to you.’ If you loved me, you would have rejoiced, because I am going to the Father, for the Father is greater than I. <sup>29.</sup> And now I have told you before it takes place, so that when it does take place you may believe. <sup>30.</sup> I will no longer talk much with you, for the ruler of this world is coming. He has no claim on me, <sup>31.</sup> but I do as the Father has commanded me, so that the world may know that I love the Father. Rise, let us go from here.
