Opening Scripture: Isaiah 66:1-16

¹. Thus says the Lord: “Heaven is My throne, and the earth is My footstool; what is the house that you would build for Me, and what is the place of My rest? ². All these things My hand has made, and so all these things came to be, declares the Lord. But this is the one to whom I will look: he who is humble and contrite in spirit and trembles at my Word. ³. “He who slaughters an ox is like one who kills a man; he who sacrifices a lamb, like one who breaks a dog's neck; he who presents a grain offering, like one who offers pig's blood; he who makes a memorial offering of frankincense, like one who blesses an idol. These have chosen their own ways, and their soul delights in their abominations; ⁴. I also will choose harsh treatment for them and bring their fears upon them, because when I called, no one answered, when I spoke, they did not listen; but they did what was evil in my eyes and chose that in which I did not delight.” ⁵. Hear the word of the Lord, you who tremble at His word: “Your brothers who hate you and cast you out for My name's sake have said, ‘Let the Lord be glorified, that we may see your joy’; but it is they who shall be put to shame. ⁶. “The sound of an uproar from the city! A sound from the temple! The sound of the Lord, rendering recompense to His enemies! ⁷. “Before she was in labor she gave birth; before her pain came upon her she delivered a son. ⁸. Who has heard such a thing? Who has seen such things? Shall a land be born in one day? Shall a nation be brought forth in one moment? For as soon as Zion was in labor she brought forth her children. ⁹. Shall I bring to the point of birth and not cause to bring forth?” says the Lord; “shall I, who cause to bring forth, shut the womb?” says your God. ¹⁰. “Rejoice with Jerusalem, and be glad for her, all you who love her; rejoice with her in joy, all you who mourn over her; ¹¹. that you may nurse and be satisfied from her consoling breast; that you may drink deeply with delight from her glorious abundance.” ¹². For thus says the Lord: “Behold, I will extend peace to her like a river, and the glory of the nations like an overflowing stream; and you shall nurse, you shall be carried upon her hip, and bounced upon her knees. ¹³. As one whom his mother comforts, so I will comfort you; you shall be comforted in Jerusalem. ¹⁴. You shall see, and your heart shall rejoice; your bones shall flourish like the grass; and the hand of the Lord shall be known to His servants, and he shall show his indignation against His enemies. ¹⁵. “For behold, the Lord will come in fire, and His chariots like the whirlwind, to render His anger in fury, and His rebuke with flames of fire. ¹⁶. For by fire will the Lord enter into judgment, and by His sword, with all flesh; and those slain by the Lord shall be many.

**Responsive Reading: 1 John 5:1-15**

Leader¹: Everyone who believes that Jesus is the Christ has been born of God, and everyone who loves the Father loves whoever has been born of Him.

Congregation²: By this we know that we love the children of God, when we love God and obey His commandments.³ For this is the love of God, that we keep His commandments. And His commandments are not burdensome.⁴ For everyone who has been born of God overcomes the world. And this is the victory that has overcome the world our faith.

Leader⁵: Who is it that overcomes the world except the one who believes that Jesus is the Son of God?

Congregation⁶: This is He who came by water and blood Jesus Christ; not by the water only but by the water and the blood. And the Spirit is the one who testifies, because the Spirit is the truth.⁷ For there are three that testify:⁸ the Spirit and the water and the blood; and these three agree.

Leader⁹: If we receive the testimony of men, the testimony of God is greater, for this is the testimony of God that He has borne concerning His Son.¹⁰ Whoever believes in the Son of God has the testimony in Himself. Whoever does not believe God has made Him a liar, because he has not believed in the testimony that God has borne concerning His Son.

Congregation¹¹: And this is the testimony, that God gave us eternal life, and this life is in his Son.¹² Whoever has the Son has life; whoever does not have the Son of God does not have life.

Leader¹³: I write these things to you who believe in the name of the Son of God, that you may know that you have eternal life.

Congregation¹⁴: And this is the confidence that we have toward Him, that if we ask anything according to His will He hears us.¹⁵ And if we know that He hears us in whatever we ask, we know that we have the requests that we have asked of Him.

Title: “What's Coming?”

Pastor's Text John 16:16-33

¹⁶ “A little while, and you will see me no longer; and again a little while, and you will see me.” ¹⁷ So some of his disciples said to one another, “What is this that he says to us, ‘A little while, and you will not see me, and again a little while, and you will see me’; and, ‘because I am going to the Father’?” ¹⁸ So they were saying, “What does he mean by ‘a little while’? We do not know what he is talking about.” ¹⁹ Jesus knew that they wanted to ask him, so he said to them, “Is this what you are asking yourselves, what I meant by saying, ‘A little while and you will not see me, and again a little while and you will see me’? ²⁰ Truly, truly, I say to you, you will weep and lament, but the world will rejoice. You will be sorrowful, but your sorrow will turn into joy. ²¹ When a woman is giving birth, she has sorrow because her hour has come, but when she has delivered the baby, she no longer remembers the anguish, for joy that a human being has been born into the world. ²² So also you have sorrow now, but I will see you again, and your hearts will rejoice, and no one will take your joy from you. ²³ In that day you will ask nothing of me. Truly, truly, I say to you, whatever you ask of the Father in my name, he will give it to you. ²⁴ Until now you have asked nothing in my name. Ask, and you will receive, that your joy may be full. ²⁵ “I have said these things to you in figures of speech. The hour is coming when I will no longer speak to you in figures of speech but will tell you plainly about the Father. ²⁶ In that day you will ask in my name, and I do not say to you that I will ask the Father on your behalf; ²⁷ for the Father himself loves you, because you have loved me and have believed that I came from God. ²⁸ I came from the Father and have come into the world, and now I am leaving the world and going to the Father.” ²⁹ His disciples said, “Ah, now you are speaking plainly and not using figurative speech! ³⁰ Now we know that you know all things and do not need anyone to question you; this is why we believe that you came from God.” ³¹ Jesus answered them, “Do you now believe? ³² Behold, the hour is coming, indeed it has come, when you will be scattered, each to his own home, and will leave me alone. Yet I am not alone, for the Father is with me. ³³ I have said these things to you, that in me you may have peace. In the world you will have tribulation. But take heart; I have overcome the world.”
