¹ My God, my God, why have you forsaken me? ^{11.} Be not far from me, for trouble is near, and there is none to help. ^{12.} Many bulls encompass me; strong bulls of Bashan surround me; ^{13.} they open wide their mouths at me, like a ravening and roaring lion. ^{14.} I am poured out like water, and all my bones are out of joint; my heart is like wax; it is melted within my breast; ^{15.} my strength is dried up like a potsherd, and my tongue sticks to my jaws; you lay me in the dust of death. ^{16.} For dogs encompass me; a company of evildoers encircles me; they have pierced my hands and feet ^{17.} I can count all my bones they stare and gloat over me; ^{18.} they divide my garments among them, and for my clothing they cast lots.

¹⁹. But you, O Lord, do not be far off! O you my help, come quickly to my aid! ²⁰. Deliver my soul from the sword, my precious life from the power of the dog! ²¹. Save me from the mouth of the lion! You have rescued me from the horns of the wild oxen! ²². I will tell of your name to my brothers; in the midst of the congregation I will praise you: ²³. You who fear the Lord, praise him! All you offspring of Jacob, glorify him, and stand in awe of him, all you offspring of Israel! ²⁴. For he has not despised or abhorred the affliction of the afflicted, and he has not hidden his face from him, but has heard, when he cried to him. ²⁵. From you comes my praise in the great congregation; my vows I will perform before those who fear him. ²⁶. The afflicted shall eat and be satisfied; those who seek him shall praise the Lord! May your hearts live forever! ²⁷. All the ends of the earth shall remember and turn to the Lord, and all the families of the nations shall worship before you. ²⁸.
